## Is There Something More?

In days gone by before the onset of periodic vertigo (thankfully it's been many years since a true episode), I loved riding roller coasters. I'm an "adrenaline junkie" and there is nothing quite like the surge of adrenaline that comes with the first drop on a roller coaster ride. But, before that first drop there is the climb up the peak. And at the crest of the peak, the roller coaster riders can look back and see from whence they came and look forward to where they are going.

As we begin our Fall season at New Hope Church, we'll begin by looking back in remembrance. Sunday, September 11 will be the tenth anniversary of the attacks on the World Trade Center and the Pentagon along with the crash of the plane in Shanksville, PA. That morning in worship we will remember the events of that day with solemnity and focus on God's faithfulness, comfort, and hope.

Then, on September 18, we'll start our forward look considering how we grow in our discipleship as followers of Jesus. During the Fall Sarah Palsma and I will be preaching on Paul's letter to the Ephesian Church, the central focus of which is growing toward spiritual maturity. We have a deep sense that many at New Hope are asking, "Is there something more to this life of following Jesus than just showing up for an hour on Sunday?" We're combining our weekly messages with a small group experience in which we hope all of you will participate. Small groups will be formed for discussion, spiritual growth and fellowship. The focus of the group discussion will be the previous Sunday's message. Sarah and I will provide discussion questions for small group facilitators that will focus on practical application of the principles for spiritual growth emerging from each week's message. We'll also include a short video clip that will help small group participants think about what they heard in Sunday's message and where that touches their spiritual growth. I encourage you to join a group and discover what kind of growth occurs when you're in relationship with other followers of Jesus.

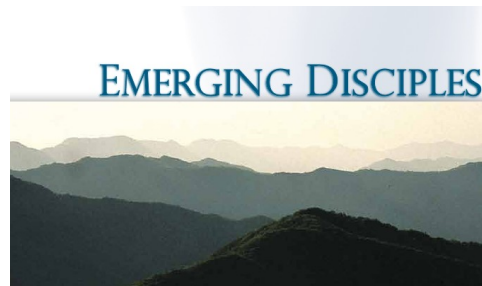

### Growing Spiritually

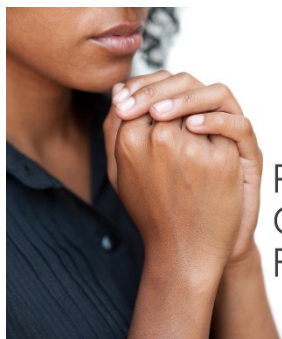

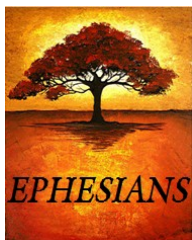

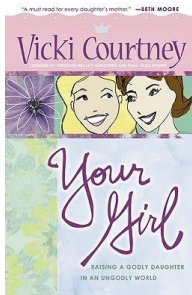
### EPHESIANS

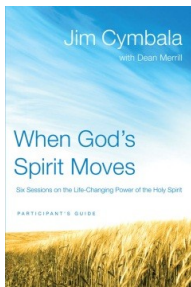

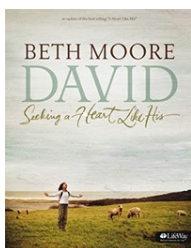


## WHEN GOD'S SPIRIT MOVES

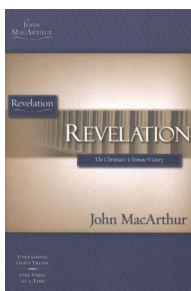

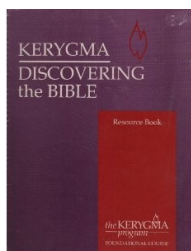

That is true for this book.

"Restoring Cultural Foundations: A Wake Up Call to America" shows, through a study of the Ten Commandments, that a return to the Judeo-Christian principles on which the Founders built our nation is imperative for an orderly society and lasting liberty. Departing from God's ways, our founders believed, courted certain disaster. And some believe that is what is happening now in America.

Each chapter covers one of the commandments and places special emphasis on application designed to improve both the spiritual strength of the family and our nation. 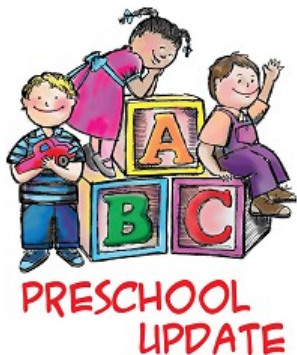

## The Welcoming Church

Welcoming is foundational. It is the test of the condition of your heart. It is a part of our gratitude. Being hospitable, inviting, and welcoming is biblically based and our church has explicitly expressed on the back side of our bulletin to be welcoming when we say, “No matter who you are or why you have come, welcome.” We are “people like you.” When we say this we are inviting everyone into our caring community.

The other parts of our core mission – friendly...relevant...celebrative...biblical... Christ-centered – would be less if we bypassed the original invitation, if we skipped over the welcome. Being welcoming and inviting are the proof of the condition of our hearts and the test of our desire for community.

How can we improve the welcome that we give to guests who join us? What a risk it is, what a brave act of seeking out God it is for a visitor to come to worship with us for the first time. How can we share the fullness of God’s love by providing a welcoming and accepting environment in this church we call our own? We want to pay attention to visitors – we need to move out of our own comfort zones to greet those who are unfamiliar to us, to invite people to cookies and coffee time, to help show someone around the church, to express that we’d love to have them join us for worship again.

We are called to be welcoming because we are welcomed by God. The task of welcoming is what we call hospitality. Biblically, hospitality is an essential part of the identity of the people of God. God challenges us to turn our eyes outward.

Welcoming congregations tend to thrive, tend to be future-oriented, tend to have visibility and impact in their communities, tend to look beyond themselves, tend to be leaders in their community, and tend to be healthy and full of vitality.

To be a welcoming church, we need to exude the message that “My church home is your church home.” This house that we’ve invited God to stay in with us, God has taken the liberty of inviting over some guests – namely, everybody else. Be welcoming because, well, because how else can one possibly be when guests are in your church home?

Look around; get to know guests and new people. Don’t know if they are new, well, they are new to you and you to them. If you think they are new and they have been at New Hope for 26 years, you both get to laugh. What a great start!
