To **Reach** people for Christ, **Root** people in Christ, and **Release** people to serve Christ.

One of the occasional "Groundhog Day" conversations that we have among staff is about how we can effectively communicate with the constituency of New Hope Church—members and attendees. It's a conversation we have over and over because, quite candidly, it's frustrating to realize that our attempts are moderately successful.

While we do not know how many people read the weekly Informer that is inserted in the worship bulletin, we can track how many people read "This Week at New Hope" that arrives via email every Friday afternoon. By the same token, while we do not know how many people read their hard copy edition of our monthly newsletter, we are able to track how many people read it online.

As I've said, our attempts at communicating are moderately successful. Somewhere between 30% and 35% of intended email recipients actually open "This Week at New Hope" and our monthly newsletter. The number who read an announcement or an article is approximately 12%. If we compare ourselves to the industry standard, I suppose we should be ecstatic with this rate of response. However, we're missing the greater percentage of our congregation with these communication media.

I'm very much aware that the prevailing opinion is that the best way to communicate important information is via an announcement in worship on Sunday morning. It's only when one realizes that, on any given Sunday, we have approximately 30% of our potential congregation in worship that the stark reality becomes clear: 70% of our congregation is not in worship on any given Sunday and therefore miss hearing what we want to communicate.

We do realize that most of us are inundated with communication that is superfluous and irrelevant. Our email inboxes are cluttered and the amount of junk mail that we receive through the USPS is distressing.

With all the aforementioned in mind, we're going to take a different approach at New Hope. Beginning this summer, we will offer a quarterly newsletter. With the reduction in frequency, we are hoping for an increase in readership. What we want to communicate to you, our members, attendees and friends truly is not fake news. We believe that it is important to our life together and we want you to be informed of all that happens here at New Hope. Now, I'll be curious to learn if anyone has read this.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Our community has felt great sadness these past few weeks. Many discussions have been had on how to best handle the hard situations facing our children. I've heard many ideas

out in the world for solutions except the one that will actually work: Jesus.

We must raise our children to know that they are fearfully and wonderfully created in the image of a mighty, loving, amazing God who purposefully created them to do His good works even before they were born.

The Bible guides us in Deuteronomy 6, where we are told of the Great Commandment: Hear, O Israel: The Lord is our God, the Lord alone. You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your might. Keep these words that I am commanding you today in your heart. Recite them to your children and talk about them when you are at home and when you are away, when you lie down and when you rise. Bind them as a sign on your hand, fix them as an emblem on your forehead and write them on the door posts of your house and on your gates.

It starts with teaching our children to follow God by leading with our lives. My daughter and I were listening to Jesus music (praise music) in the kitchen while prepping dinner one day last week. *Undeniable* by Toby Mac struck my heart. He sings, "from the hymns that my Daddy sang, I knew I was glorified to praise your name. From the prayers that my Momma prayed, I know I was made to glorify your name." My hands were in the air and so were our daughter's. Our children learn from watching us.

So let them see you study your Bible. Let them see you praising and worshiping Jesus. Let them see you serving your fellow brothers and sisters. And let them see you pray through both praise and struggle. Let them see you forgive and ask for forgiveness. Tell them His stories! This is how our children will come to know God. They will know Him because we've shared Him.

Your Children's Ministry Team is humbled to help you teach God's story to your children.




