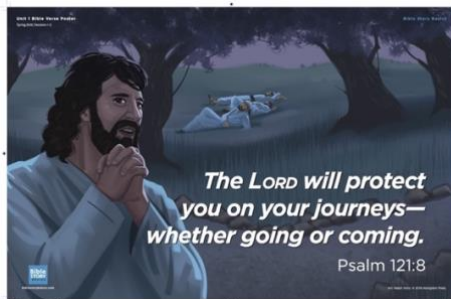

Sunday School Lessons

Preschool through 3rd grade:

You'll find Sunday School Sessions 4 & 5 in the attachments. The entire lesson is included but there are many sections that you likely won't be able to do at home. Hopefully you can pick out a couple of things that you can do. Even if you just read the Bible Story and discuss it with your child. If you have access to a printer, you can print the activity/coloring page at the end of the lesson.

Pre-Reader: Purple, Red and Blue Fish.
Reader: Orange, Yellow, and Green Fish.

Session 4: In the Garden, [Matthew 26: 31-56](#)

Session 5: Peter, [Matthew 26:57-58, 69-75](#)

4th & 5th grade:

In the Sunday School Lesson for this week, Jesus takes Peter, James and John (some of his closest disciples) up on a mountain and his glory is revealed there. You can read about it in Matthew 17: 1- 13

Can you think of other important events in the Bible that happened on a mountain? Perhaps, the delivery of the Ten Commandments on Mt. Sinai? Or the Sermon on the Mount?

This story comes at a point of change and transition in Jesus' ministry. The week before he was teaching and healing and feeding a crowd of four thousand. Not much later he would be moving on to Jerusalem where his triumphant entry would be followed by his trial and death...

In the Transfiguration story, Jesus' face "shines like the sun" and he meets with Moses and Elijah, Old Testament "greats". Peter is so excited he wants pitch some tents and stay on the mountain, although he does get a bit scared when a voice from a cloud announces "This is my Son, whom I love, with him I am well pleased. Listen to Him" But Jesus gets the disciples up, tells them not to be afraid and brings them back

down the mountain to reality. The special memories of the glowing mountain top experience will help the disciples as they face difficult times when Jesus dies. Later in his ministry Peter remembers this special time (see 2 Peter 1: 16-18).

Here is a video using Lego figures to help you remember the story and our Bible verse: **"But Jesus came and touched them. "Get up," he said, "Don't be afraid. Matthew 17:7**
